Benefits of ISA Participation

ISA BENEFIT	DESCRIPTION
Exemption from Audits	ISA participation removes the importer from the government's comprehensive audit pool, and exempts it from focused assessments, duty drawback examinations, and foreign trade zone reviews.
Speed of Cargo Release	ISA participation is a positive factor in Customs' selectivity program, which affects cargo release.
Enhanced Prior Disclosure Rights	If Customs becomes aware of facts that may represent a Customs violation, an ISA participant receives a written notice of errors from Customs and has 30 days from the date of notification to file a prior disclosure, thus ending or greatly mitigating penalty exposure.
Additional Guidance	Customs can provide ISA participants with consultation, guidance, and training, as requested, including access to a hotline with key liaison officials.
Greater Flexibility	Companies will have the opportunity to apply for coverage of multiple business units and are entitled to receive entry summary trade data, including analysis support.
Less Government Oversight	Customs promises ISA participants less intrusion and additional benefits tailored to industry needs, by mutual agreement.
